EDT provided structural engineering professional services for the Public Safety and Municipal City Building in Smyrna, Georgia as part of the city's Downtown Modernization Program. The facility was constructed with structural steel framing, composite deck and hipped roof, supported on shallow foundation with x-bracing used for the wind load on the structure.

EDT also provided the structural engineering services for this facility housing the 911 emergency center, police headquarters and City of Smyrna Jail. This unique combination required a variety of materials to be used to achieve the desired architectural objective.

The police and 911 centers were constructed from structural steel. CMU load bearing walls and one-way flat slab for the roof was utilized for the jail segment.
