Engineering Design Technologies, Inc. (EDT) provided civil and structural design for the new Classroom and Convocation Center for use by the Department of Health, Physical Education and Sport Sciences, and the Department of Public Administration and Human Services. The facility is also used by the University for large general assemblies. The design provided for a new 6,000-seat multi-purpose convocation center with a 25,000 SF classroom wing for health, physical education and sports science instruction, totaling 147,000 SF.

Site work design provided by EDT included a new sidewalk; storm water drainage system; utilities interfaces; site furnishings and related landscape and lighting. Due to significant space restrictions, special enhancements to the storm water drainage system were designed featuring an underground detention structure to maximize space allocation. The site work also included the design of a service drive connecting the Convocation Center to the parking deck. The Convocation Center is adjacent to Kennesaw Hall, the Admissions Office with a designed landscape courtyard between the two buildings.
