Engineering Design Technologies, Inc. (EDT) performed construction of the 5-station Urban Assault Course at Fort Bragg, North Carolina. Intended for the purpose of urban tactical training, the 10 acre site accommodated six (6) buildings and one (1) underground training facility. Station One was defined as an Individual Tactical Training Team Facility. Station Two is defined as a Squad/Platoon Tactical Training Facility. Station Three was defined as a Grenadier/Gunnery Practice Facility. Station Four was defined as an Offensive/Defensive Tactical Facility. In addition to the four (4) above ground stations, EDT was also responsible for the construction of an Operations and Storage Facility and an After Action Covered Bleacher area.

Sitework was comprised of over 60% of the work included in the contract, and included issues with bad soil and high underground water table. The project was delivered within budget and on time.
