Engineering Design Technologies, Inc. (EDT) was awarded a design/build contract for the 43,000 square feet Golden Knights Headquarters at Fort Bragg, North Carolina. In addition to performing the construction, EDT provided all the engineering services including civil, structural, mechanical, plumbing and fire protection.

Serving as the home to the celebrated Golden Knights Parachute Team, the design approach celebrated the historical context of Ft. Bragg. The technology that allows a soldier weighing 150 pounds or more, to safely deplane several thousand feet above the earth, is illustrated in the light steel frame that supports the arched roof over the Public Affairs and Recruiting Support Center portion of the building.

The project was submitted and received the Gold Spirit Award under the Corps of Engineers program similar to the LEED-NC program used today. EDT received the Sustained Superior Safety Performance Award from the Savannah District Corps of Engineers for its outstanding construction performance.
