EDT provided site civil engineering drawings showing site grading and drainage, new site retaining walls, utilities, paving, several storm drain relocations, as well as numerous utility relocations. The Richard B. Russell Federal Building (RBR) is a 1.25 million square foot mixed use facility located in downtown Atlanta that houses the U.S. District Court, Northern District of Georgia/Atlanta Division, and offices for several other federal agencies, including DOE's Atlanta Regional Office. The RBR, which opened in 1979, is named for Georgia's Senator Richard B. Russell, who served in the U.S. Senate from 1933-1971
